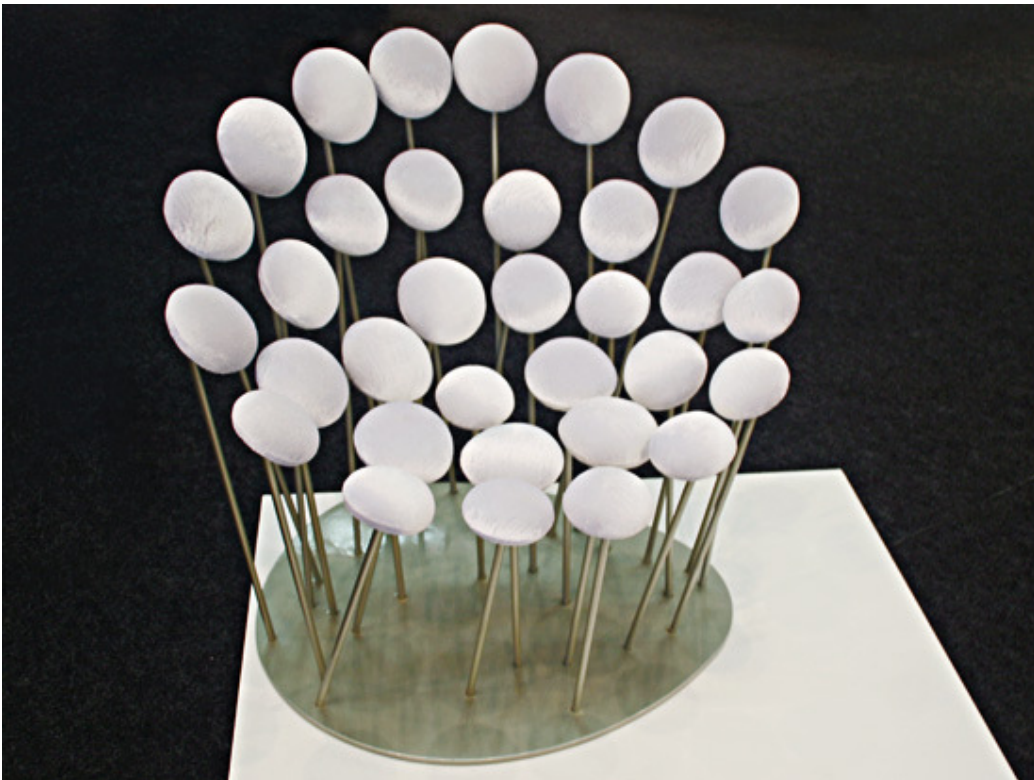

applying colors on the top surface to create a pattern.

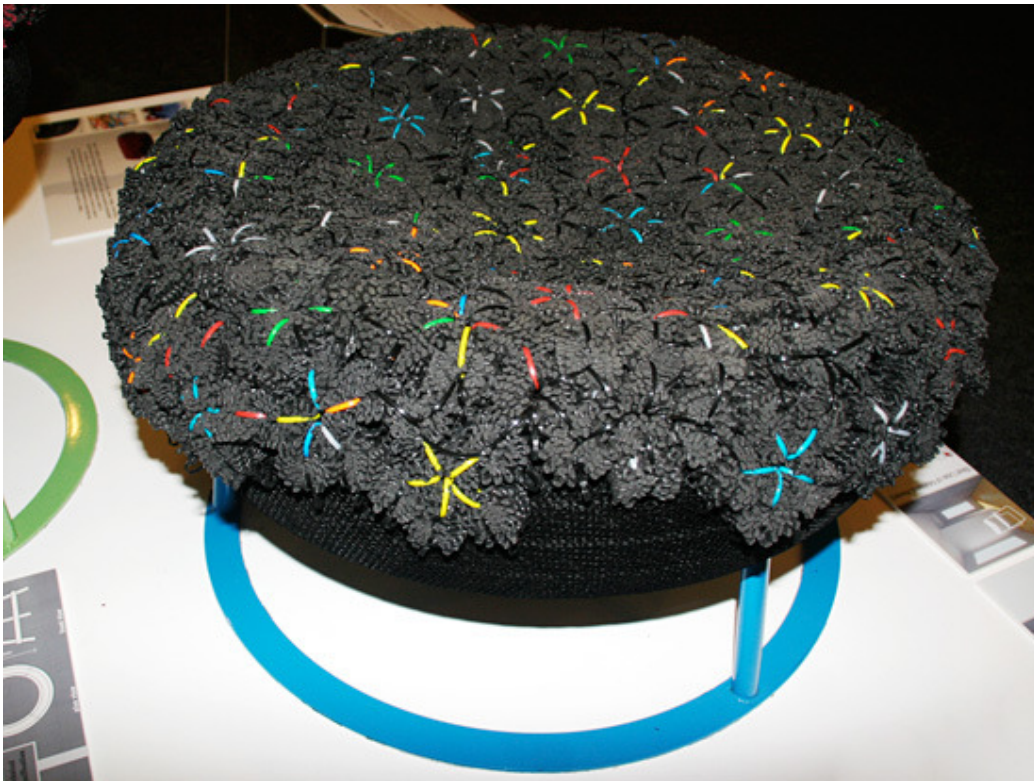

seatbelts from manufacturing surpluses are wrapped tightly around a metal frame to create a chair to sit, lounge or lay on.

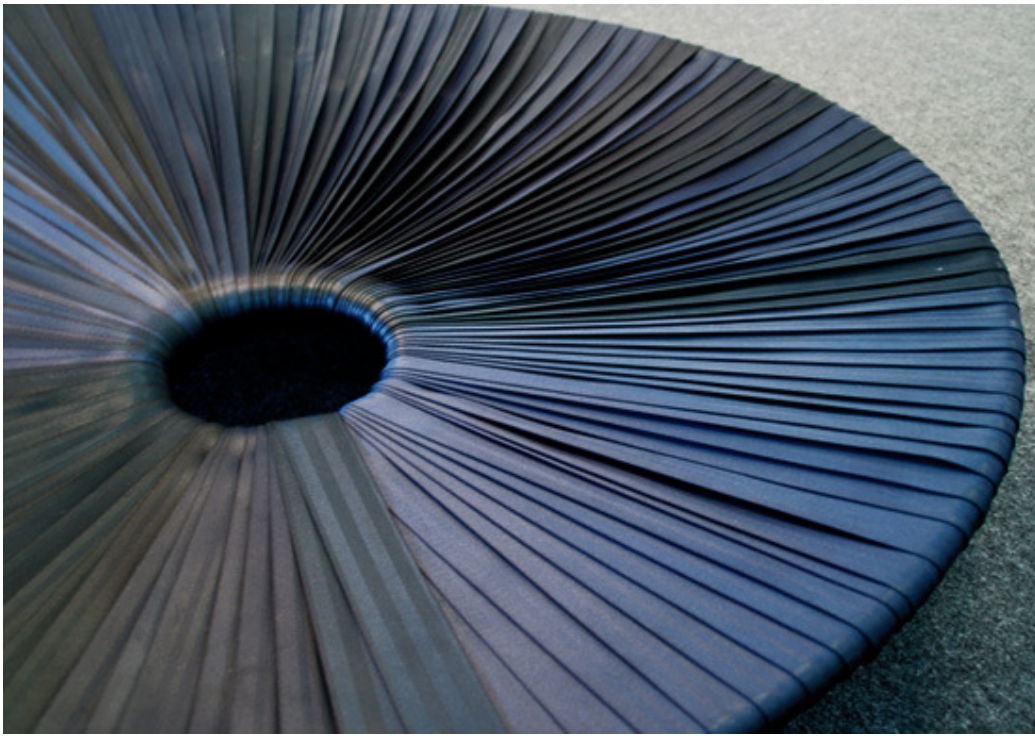

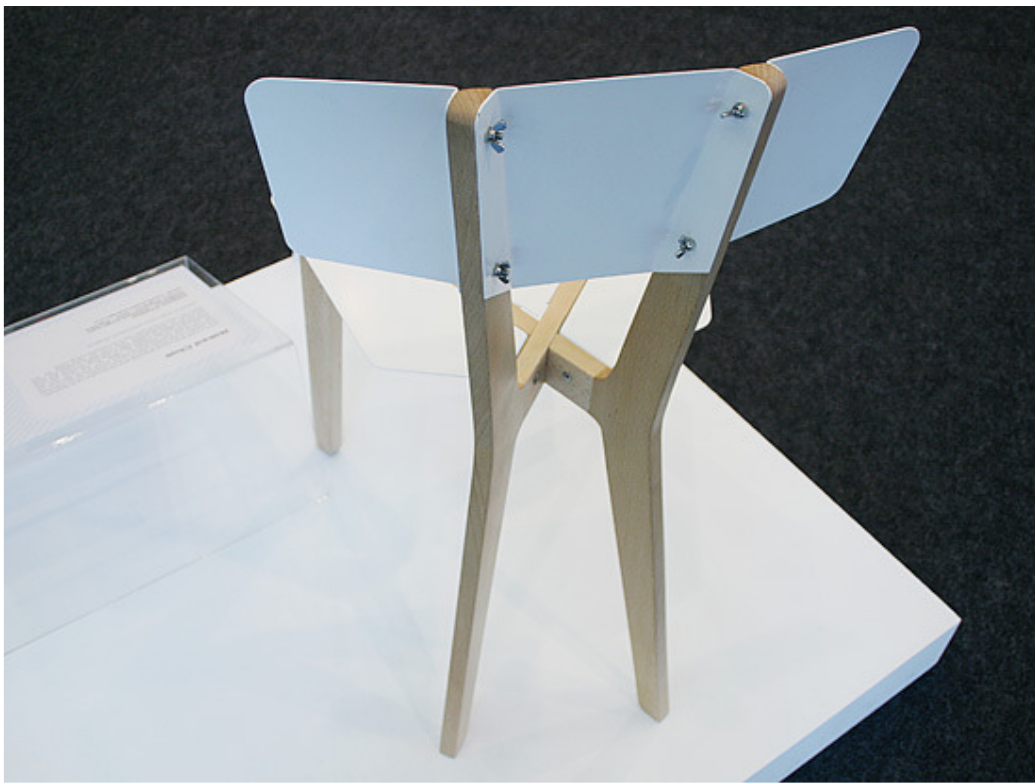
