James Goh is the new president of the Singapore Furniture Industries Council, the representative body of 95 percent of manufacturers here. Goh is executive chairman and managing director of mainboard listed Loxone International which has received a number of accolades including the Singapore Business Superbrands 2010.



SAM GOI

Entrepreneur and investor Sam Goi is otherwise known as the Popiah King for the spring roll skins and frozen convenience foods his company Tee Yih Jia Manufacturing sells to the world. It has production facilities in Singapore, Malaysia, China and the US, and exports 90 percent of products. A

board member of the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry and honorary past president of the Enterprise 50 Association, Goi supports numerous grassroots and community activities.



GOH KEE NGUAN

CEO of the Singapore Youth Olympic Games Organising Committee Goh Kee Nguan successfully staged the first Youth Olympic Games. And in recognition of his contributions, Goh was presented with the Olympic Order in Silver by the International Olympic Committee. He was formerly a senior commander in the Singapore Armed Forces (SAF) noted for leading the SAF joint task force for tsunami relief efforts in Indonesia in 2005.



GOH YEW LIN

While Goh Yew Lin, managing director of GE, Goh Holdings and director of Temasek Holdings pursues a career in the financial services, he is also widely known as a respected patron of the arts. In September, he was appointed chairman of Singapore Symphony Company after 10 years on the board, including eight years as its deputy chair. That same month, wide-ranging recommendations of the Censhery Review Committee, which he chairs, were also released. Goh also serves as chairman of the Yong Siew Toh Conservatory and was formerly a music critic for a local newspaper.

KAY GOON

The barrister-at-law from Gray's Inn, London, works full-time in her family business, the Kaok Group of Companies. Also known as Kay Kaok Don Karong, she is executive chairman of Shangri-La Hotel Singapore, president of the Singapore Hotel Association, chairman of the National Healthcare Group and sits on the advisory boards of the National University Hospital and the Nanyang Business School among others. She is also an avid supporter of the arts.



PIYUSH GUPTA

Piyush Gupta, the former Citic man who joined South-east Asia's largest bank DBS in late 2009 kicked his post-cession strategy into gear and delivered a 28 percent increase in third-quarter 2010 earnings.
