









Furniture Industry Trade Performance

Buoyant – that is the mood to describe the Singapore furniture industry as it summed up its performance for 2005. And it's no surprise, given an industry report card with figures to be proud of.

The Singapore furniture industry has grown into a significant billion-dollar-a-year business, with a robust 18 per cent growth in the total furniture trade to S\$968 million in 2005. Both exports and imports saw a commendable 41% and 12% growth respectively and this only covers trade done out of Singapore. Based on

industry survey, the combined exports for the industry players' local and overseas operations should hit almost S\$1.6 billion during the year in review.

The main bulk of the industry's core business is segmented into three primary groups: manufacturing, retail/wholesale and contract manufacturing. Whilst no official figures are available on the contract sector, the other two main segments of the industry comprised 2,089 companies employing 14,395 people.

Of the 681 furniture manufacturers, 65% of the 172 larger establishments have subsidiary manufacturing plants in regional countries such as China, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam.

Note:

- The export figures do not truly reflect the industry performance as it only represents the value of goods shipped directly from manufacturing plants located in Singapore.
- With regionalisation of manufacturing operations, more furniture manufactured by Singapore companies is being shipped directly from overseas production centres. These figures are, however, not captured in our official statistics.
- Based on the Furniture ICAP survey, the combined exports from industry players' local and overseas operations are estimated at almost S\$1.6 billion.
